WATER OUTAGE

In the event of a water outage, the following procedures should be followed:

- 1. Check for outage alert (subscribe to alerts on our website)
- 2. Report outage on District website
- 3. If website access is an issue, call (405) 969-2646 (office)

When reporting an outage, please have your Benefit Unit number or service location ready. This information will be necessary for us to provide reliable and accurate information.

If outage occurs after-hours, please call (580) 370-8644.

FINAL NOTICE - DELINQUENT ACCOUNT

Final notices, for delinquent accounts, are mailed on the 16th of each month (unless the 16th falls on a weekend). A phone call will also be made on that same day. These phone calls are made in a timely manner, as cut-offs occur one week after the delinquent notice is mailed. Please be kind to our office staff, if you receive a final notice or call. This is a service they provide for your benefit.
